Board-certified by the American Board of Internal Medicine – Infectious Disease, Catena attained his medical degree from the University of Rome (Italy) School of Medicine; completed his internship and residency in internal medicine at Mountainside Hospital in Mont Clair, New Jersey; and fellowship in infectious disease from St. Michael's Medical Center in Newark, New Jersey.

As part of the medical practice's ongoing commitment to excellence and quality patient care, TEPAS Healthcare hosts two veteran ARNPs, Nikka Cohan and Simone Paul. Cohan, who received her Master of Science degree in nursing from the University of Cincinnati, has been with TEPAS since 2014.
